History of its origin

IFIM School of Law's maiden national-level event, **CONCORDAT 2019**, featured a Hybrid Negotiation and Mediation competition, enhancing legal and negotiation skills of the participants. Judges included International Arbitrators, Mediators, and various experts from the ADR fraternity.

Following its success, **CONCORDAT 2.0** evolved by inculcating Client Counselling, Negotiation, Mediation, and Arbitration into two segments, namely- "C-Neg" and "Med-Arb" respectively. Spanning over three days, based on Sports Law and International Law themes, it further transformed into an ADR Fest, merging competition with cultural festivities, celebrating ADR among students.

FORMAT OF THE COMPETITION

CONCORDAT 3.0 will spread over three days and two categories of competitions, each category of the competition (C-Neg and Med-Arb) shall have four rounds: Preliminary, Quarters, Semi-Finals, and Finals.

1st Category: Client Counselling and Negotiation (C-Neg)

2nd Category: Mediation and Arbitration (Med-Arb)

Each Category has the following structure:

PRELIMS:

C-Neg- Client Counselling (Qualifying Rounds)

Med-Arb- Mediation (Qualifying Rounds)

QUARTERS:

C-Neg- Client Counselling (Qualifying Rounds)

Med-Arb- Mediation (Knock outs)

SEMIFINALS:

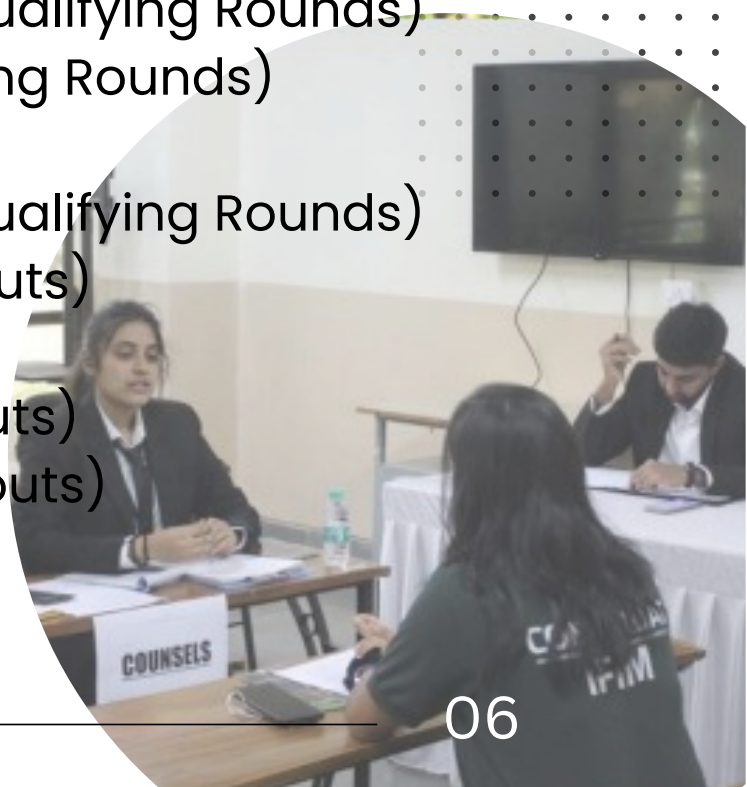
C-Neg- Negotiation (Knock outs)

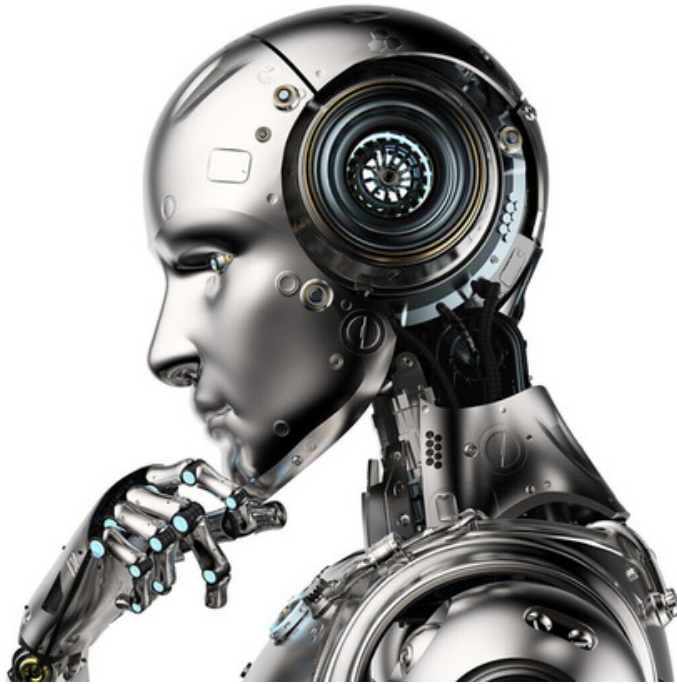
Med-Arb- Arbitration (Knock outs)

C-NEG FORMAT

THEME: Technology Law and Artificial Intelligence.

REGISTRATION:

- Each team shall comprise of two students. Both the members will undertake the role of Counsels for Client-Counselling and further one Counsel and one Client for the Negotiation round.
- The Registration Fee for C-Neg is **INR 2500/-** per person without accommodation and **INR 3000/-** per person with accommodation.



MED-ARB FORMAT

THEME: Insolvency and Bankruptcy Law.

REGISTRATION:

- Each team shall comprise three members— one Mediator, one Client, and one Counsel for Mediation, which shall convert to two Speakers and one Researcher for the Arbitration rounds.
- The Registration Fee for Med-Arb is **INR 2500/-** per person without accommodation and **INR 3000/-** per person with accommodation.
